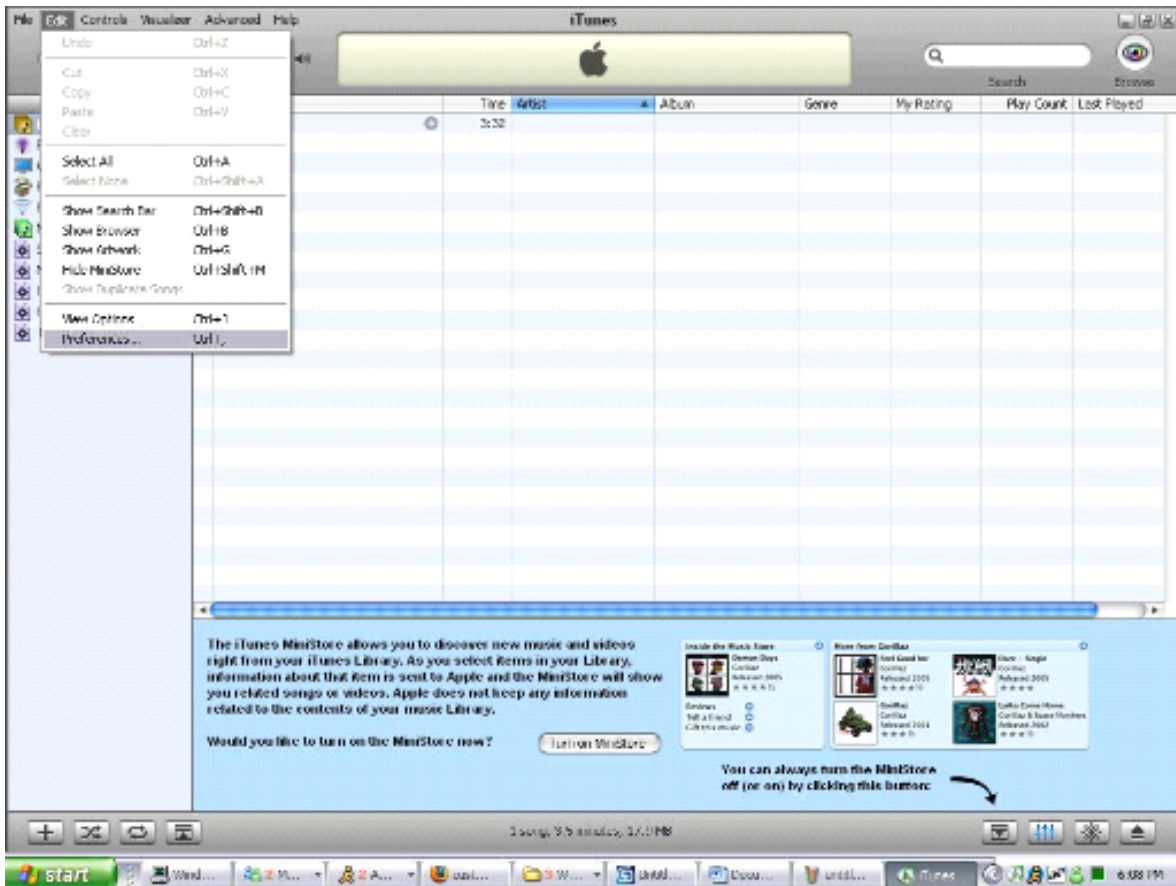


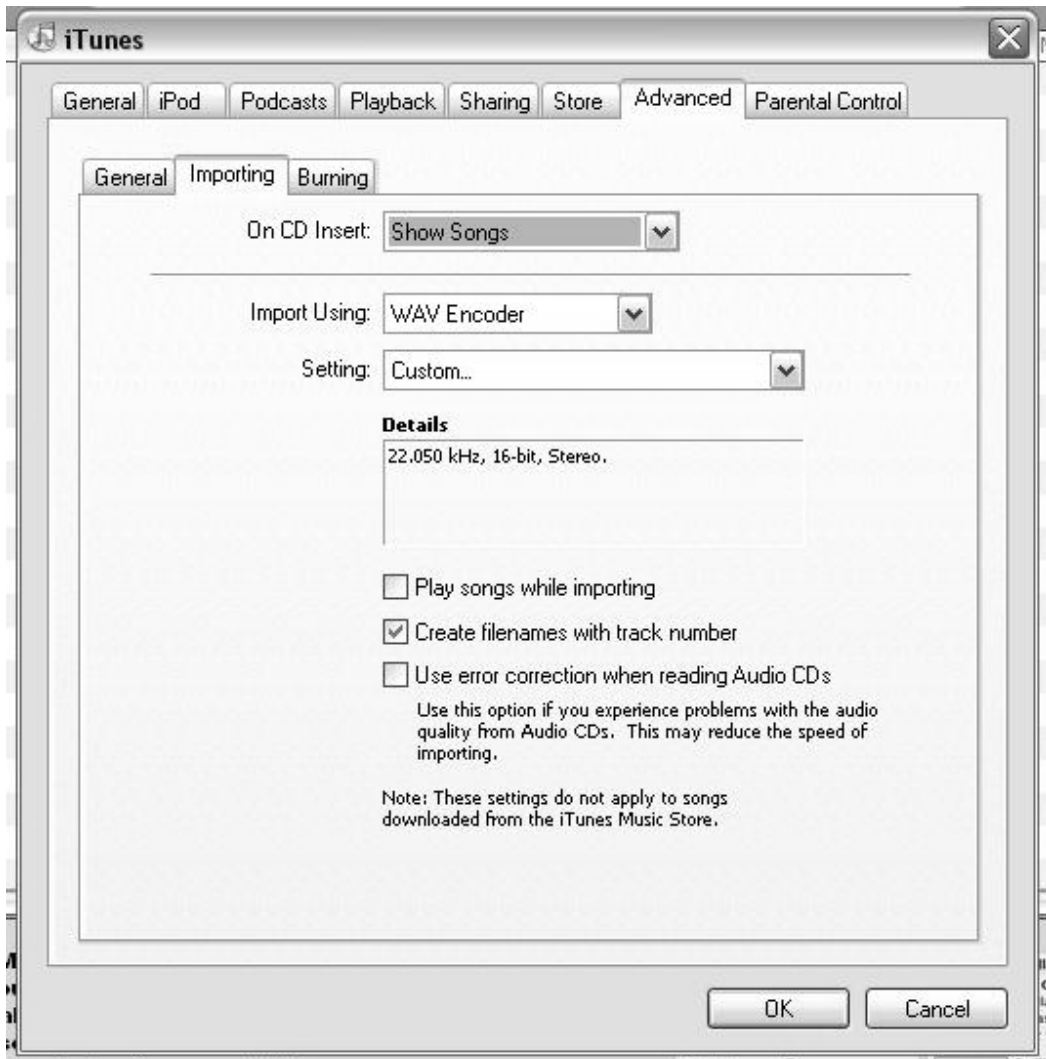
# Custom sound tutorial

You need itunes, sound recorder(default windows program), Tool(kind a obvious lol)

First, you are going to make your sound file a .Wav file, you open itunes, and go to preferences



pick import options, choose your import option to be .wav, you can make it so you don't have to use sound recorder, the settings for low sound quality are 22.050 HZs 16 bit stereo (don't know what high quality is cause low has been good enough for me)



Right click the song, and now pick convert to wav



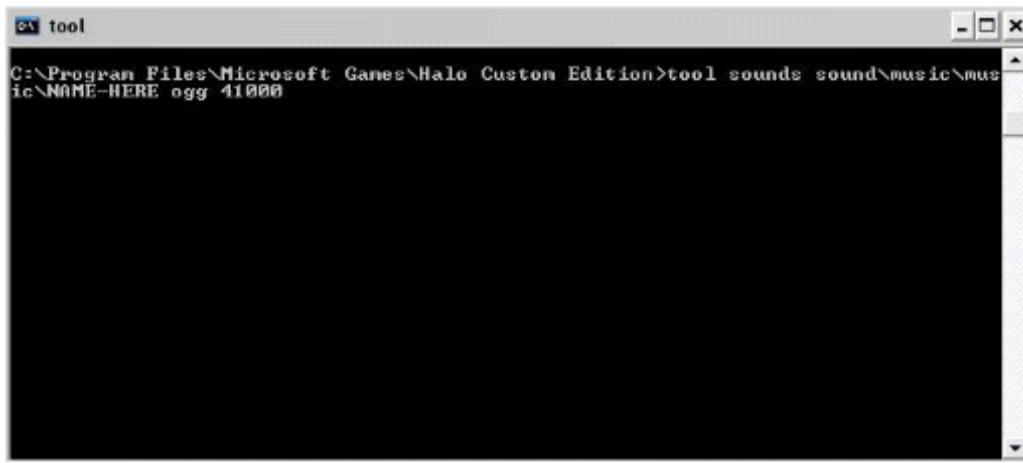
So if you are using sound recorder, you open your .wav file, save as, options , same settings as above, PCM settings as 22.050 HZs 16 bit stereo save it into data\sound\music\music\NAME-HERE\NAME-
